This app is designed to help students improve their ability to construct grammatically correct sentences. The who, what, where, and why parts of sentences are color coded to help students understand how combinations of these parts create basic sentence structure. It will aid in recognition of the parts of sentences such as nouns, verbs, and prepositions. Also, students have the opportunity to record their sentences in their own voice to improve expressive language skills. This is useful for ELL's because they will be able to distinguish the different parts of the sentence easily, as well as use pictures to help comprehend the text. The teacher could then apply this to writing, using the same color-coding idea. The students will be familiar with the parts of the sentences so this will enhance their writing.

Going from reading words to reading books is a big gap. This app provides the missing link: reading sentences. Short (2 and 3 word) sentences help children gain confidence in reading. The first mode is sentence building; the children move the words into their correct position. The second mode is the reading mode; children read the words of the phrase or sentence and then check their work by touching the hidden picture. The picture is hidden so the player will read the words first and then use the picture to check their work. ELLs will benefit from gaining confidence through practice with short sentences and corresponding pictures.

Shake-N-Tell is an interactive storytelling app that encourages children to be the storytellers. Basic story structures (characters, plot, actions) are given to the user. The storyteller reads prompts that guide them through adventures with new twists and turns at every shake of the iPad. Then they tell the story out loud by adding description, expression, and dialogue. This is good for ELLs because it is teaching writing skills such as adding details, dialogue, and creativity while practicing reading. Doing this orally helps children understand the concept before applying it to their writing. Teachers could use this to show the power of details and dialogue to children who do not have strong writing skills yet. Speech with Milo is a sequencing and storytelling game. Three picture cards are given, along with a specific topic. Basic sequencing skills are belt by ordering the three cards to show Milo and his sidekick Melvin performing a task. The player puts the picture cards into the correct order and then watches the story come to life. The app also provides options to view hints and hear the sentence read aloud. This app will allow students to organize time, sentence, and storytelling concepts using familiar themes. ELLs often have trouble sequencing; by using this app to practice simple sequencing activities it will aid in their comprehension of stories.

Story Patch allows children to create their own stories; it is fun and easy to use. There are story themes to help the user build the story or they can create their own from scratch. The child gets to choose the characters, objects, and setting for the story from a wide range of clipart or photos from their own library. After creating the picture, they enter text on a virtual keyboard before viewing the story they created. The app will even help the child write a story, which differs depending on how they answer questions. This is great for ELLs because they won't have writers block and they'll begin to feel more confident with writing stories. This app allows them to practice writing, if they choose to write their own stories, and reading. Creating their own story will make them excited to read it and will build their enjoyment of reading.

This app offers writing practice for beginning readers to build skills with vowels, blends, and digraphs. Each skill starts with a teaching sequence and is followed with opportunities for practice. The target word is displayed with optional tracing guidelines in which players can use their finger to trace each letter. After tracing, the app gives the sound of the letter, blend, or digraph and repeats the word. This app keeps records of the child's efforts. This is great for ELLs because parents and teachers can even assign practice on troublesome letter sounds and create individualized or thematic words lists from built-in words.
